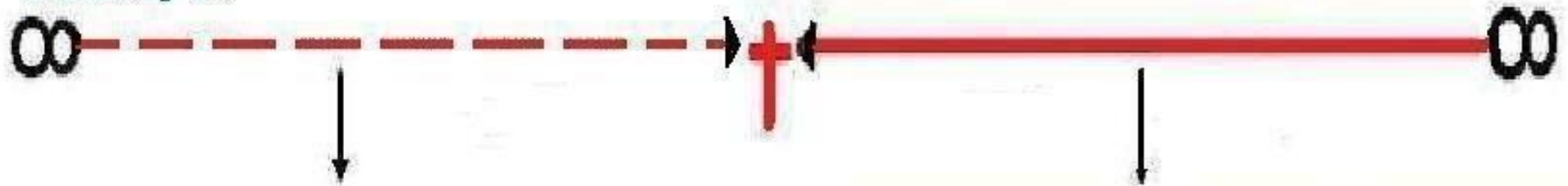


**There is only one Redemptive Covenant having two historical stages**

**Old Covenant/Animal Blood**  
**Temporal until Christ**

The animal sacrifices of the Old Covenant only covered sin. They were implemented in Eden and ran until Christ Jesus finished his work on the cross and the New Covenant became operational at Pentecost with the Holy Spirit's coming to permanently indwell believers, Hebrews 9:18-28; 10:4.

**New Covenant/Christ's Blood**  
**Permanent**

The New Covenant forgives all believers' sin from Adam to the end of the world. It could forgive anyone's sin who would personally receive Jesus Christ as savior! The saints who were obedient to the Old Covenant before Christ waited for the completion found in Christ, Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14; Hebrews 12:24; 13:20.
