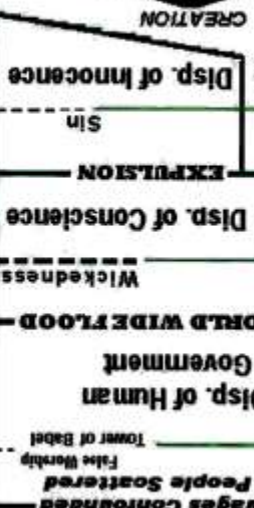

The First Prophetic Covenant was prophesied and revealed to man for his redemption in Genesis 3:15. The actual word covenant is not used until Noah but the power and victory of the Redemptive covenant is revealed here; the implementation was when the first animal sacrifice was offered by God as a gift, and Adam and Eve accepting this blood sacrificial offering as a covering by the hand of God. A blood sacrifice was/is for sin as later revealed in scripture, Hebrew 9:22 and as the two stages of the Redemptive Covenant unfold, (called the Old or New Covenant).
