The Lake of Fire for the Lost is forever, Revelation 20:14,15; 21:8

The Transition starts with the release of Satan from the Bottomless Pit or Abyss
 Revelation 20:7 When the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison.
Many Born during the 1,000 yrs. follow Satan attacking the Lord Jesus Messiah and His people and the City He loves.
 Revelation 20:7-9 When the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth—Gog and Magog—to gather them for battle.
Satan is thrown into the Lake of Fire where the Beast and false prophet were thrown at the start of the 1,000 yrs.
 Revelation 20:10 And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
The Transition ends with the Great White Throne Judgment
 Revelation 20:11-15 Then I saw a great white throne and all non-believers are thrown into the Lake of Fire.

The Seven Principles of the Dispensation

1. The Universal Principles are those already revealed in the other dispensations, but now the universal rule of God through the prophesied Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ takes the eternal position on earth which will last for eternity. The final step before Jesus puts Himself under God the Father in completion of fulfilling the change of command as the Godhead ordained. Revelation 2:27;11:15;12:5;15:3, Revelation 19, Psalm 68:16, Psalm 72, Isaiah 9:7, Luke 1:33, 1 Corinthians 15:27, 28, Revelation 22:12-21
2. The Rules that Changed because of man's failure in the former dispensation came from two dispensations, the Dispensation of Promise and the Dispensation of Grace. The Punitive Judgment of the Tribulation or 70th week of Daniel's prophecy was the judgment of both dispensations. Israel's rejection changed from the Nation that was to the Remnant which made up the New Nation of Israel redeemed out of the Tribulation period. Those who endured the Tribulation are now the recipients of the repopulation of the Kingdom dispensation. The Body of Christ now rules and reigns with the saints of the other dispensations which were before. Also those martyred in the Tribulation are resurrected to rule and reign with Christ Jesus. Christ Jesus rules in this dispensation with strictness of holiness, righteousness and justice. 1 Corinthians 6:2,3, Ephesians 2:1-22, 1 Thessalonians 4:13,14, Psalm 22:22-31; Isaiah 2:1-5, The Books of Prophets - Minor and Major Prophets tell of these truths over and over!
3. The New Rules which govern the new dispensation's operation. These are unique to this dispensation and not found in the preceding dispensations. The rules which change from number two are the longevity of man's life, the animal kingdom not killing each other and their friendliness with mankind. The New Jerusalem with Christ sitting on David's Throne ruling the world will be the place of the governing administration during the Millennium. The nations bring their offerings and gifts to the Nation of Israel and the respect coming from the nations of the world. Psalm 89:1-37; Isaiah 11,12; 14:1,2, The Books of Prophets - Minor and Major Prophets tell of these truths over and over!
4. The Stewardship, ordained of God, to fulfill His plan. God chose a stewardship to carry out the spiritual operation which will be each nation in obedience to Christ's rule. The families of each nation are responsible to teach their children the truths of God. The Messiah's reign with the Nation of Israel as His beloved Nation ruling through them and the Church, the Body of Christ, whose members are now in their glorified bodies with the saints from the other dispensations. God's chain of command will be Jesus Christ Messiah, King of Kings, Lord of Lords, (Matthew 2:6, Revelation 1:4, 17:14, 19:11-16, Micah 5:1-5), Alpha and Omega, (Revelation 1:8, 21:6, 22:13). Ruling through the Church, 'the called out believers' of all former dispensations who were Raptured (1 Corinthians 6:2,3, 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18) and those of the tribulation who were martyred for their faithfulness and given their glorified bodies at the beginning of the Millennial Kingdom, (Revelation 1:5-8, 2:6-11, 25-29; 20:4-6). Also, the believers who lived through the Tribulation in their natural, physical bodies will enter the Millennial Kingdom and be subject to the redeemed New Israel Nation. The New Nation of Israel will be those who received the Lord Jesus as savior and Messiah. This New Israel will be in a commanding relationship of authority under Messiah's rule, (Romans 11:25-27; Isaiah 10:20-22; 28:5-6; Jeremiah 23:1-7; Romans 9:22-29). Those resurrected at the beginning of the Millennial Kingdom are resurrected in what is called in Scripture the first resurrection, (Revelation 2:16-17; 3:11-13; 4:6; 7:9-17; 12:10-12; 14:1-4; 15:1-4; 19:6-9; 20:4-6). The first resurrection is prophesied, the Rapture resurrection is not, it is part of the mystery dispensation not revealed in other dispensations so it is not mentioned prior to the Pauline writings. The first resurrection mentioned in Revelation 20:4-6, will only be those who were martyred in the Tribulation, were as the Rapture will be all believers of all previous dispensation and, both groups from the Rapture and first resurrection will rule with Christ Jesus in the Millennial Kingdom.
5. The Failure of Man's obedience in the stewardship by those born in the Millennial Kingdom to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ, under a perfect Ruler without any Satanic influence. Followed by not turning from their sins by 100 years old and ending with an unknown number following Satan when released from his prison, they attack God's beloved city and its people with the intent to destroy Jesus Christ and His rule in the Battle of Gog and Magog, Isaiah 65:20, Revelation 20:7-10.
6. The Transition to the new dispensation extends from the release of Satan out of the Abyss, being held there for the 1,000 years, to the end of the Great White Throne Judgment, and the creation of the New Heaven and Earth, Revelation 20-21:1-8
7. The Punitive Judgment from God is the victory of Christ, the Messiah in the battle of Gog and Magog followed by the Great White Throne eternal Judgment of the lost.

Revelation 21:6 He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To him who is thirsty I will give to drink without cost from the spring of the water of life. 7 He who overcomes will inherit all this, and I will be his God and he will be my son. 8 But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—their place will be in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."
